Code of Conduct

Welcome to the Women Lead Local Government Fellowship. We know you care as much about privacy, the support and promotion of women and community building as we do, so please read the Code of Conduct thoroughly and ensure you support the culture it seeks to build.

Please do:

- Promote the program's aims by speaking with your peers and networks about the importance of increasing the number of women voted into local government.
- Seek to support others on the Fellowship, knowing that more women on local government councils is better for everybody.
- Speak to others within the Fellowship programming and outside of programming, in a respectful and empathetic way.
- Listen with civility to the views of others, even if those views don't align with yours
- Please keep the interactive nature of the Fellowship in mind, as a core element of the program, and keep your camera turned on during online sessions.
- Please communicate in an appropriate way when online, for example, ensuring that "Caps lock" is off to avoid miscommunication.
- The fellowship requires you to attend a minimum of 8 masterclass sessions. In the case of illness, please contact the facilitator prior to the masterclass commencing.
- Request of your fellow participants if you have their consent, prior to sharing of names and images during the program.

Please do not:

- Share names and images during the program without consent of those participants.
- Tag or name Fellows on social media without consent
- Take photos of Fellows without their consent
- Post photos of Fellows without their consent
- Quote the words, meaning or content of Fellows, outside of the Fellowship program
- Record others on digital devices without consent
- Share unsolicited advertisements or messages for your own commercial benefit
- Post or share (even privately) inappropriate material
